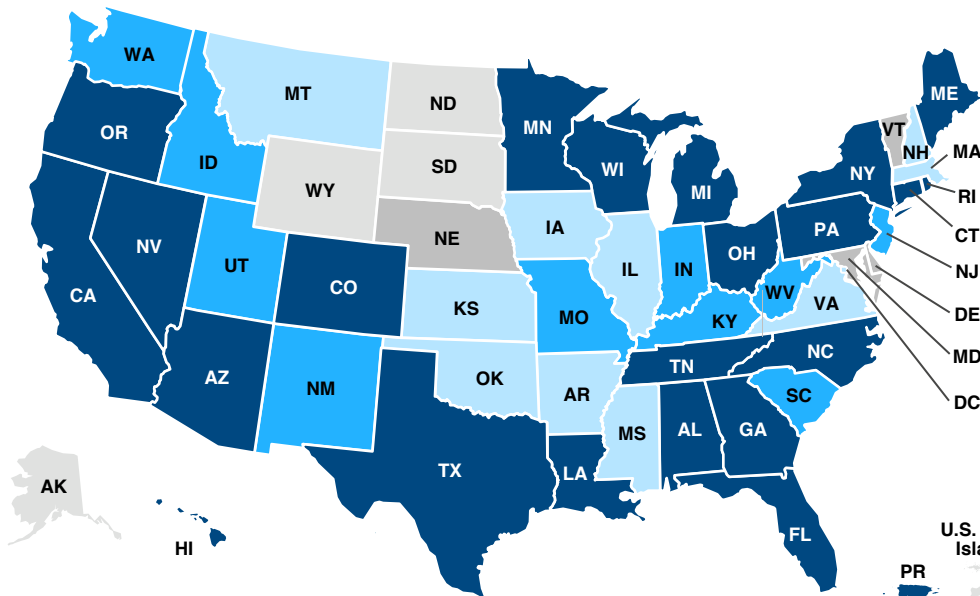
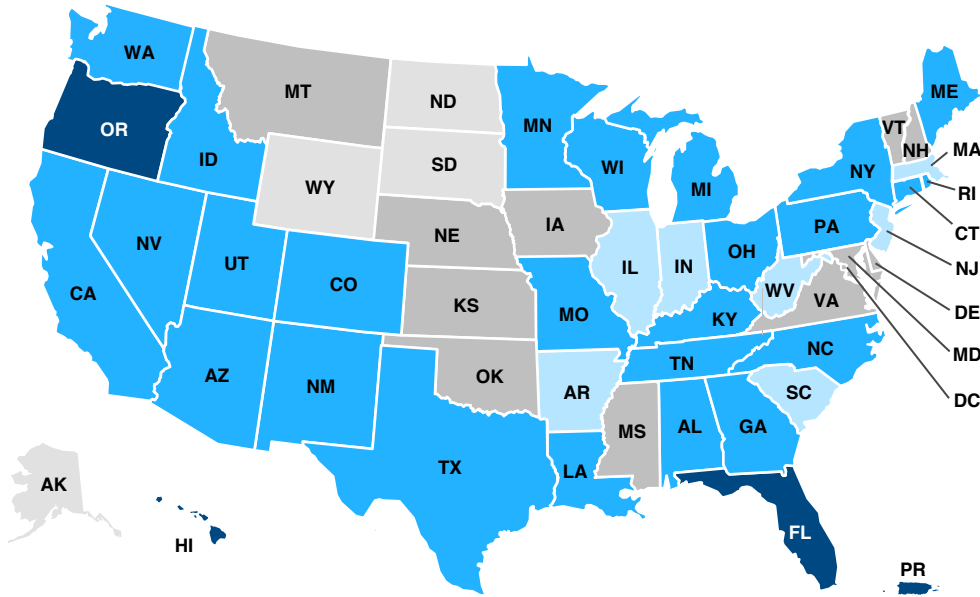
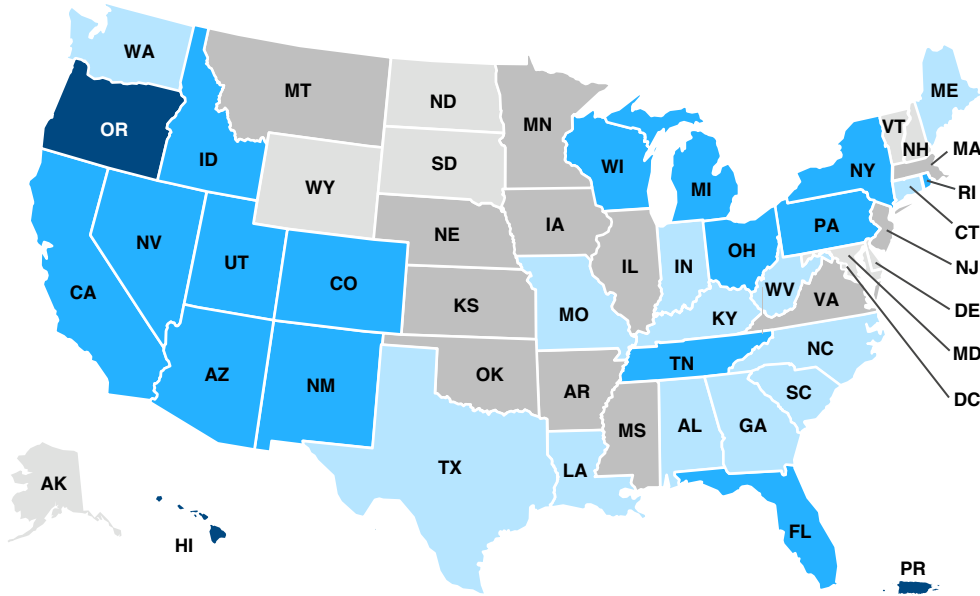


MA Enrollment Growth
